**CLAYDON**

As suspected, the planning application for a marina on the outskirts of the village has been re-submitted.

It comes at an opportune time for the applicants and a difficult time for those wishing to object, with Covid 19 preventing any public meeting or informal gatherings to discuss the issues. However, it is important to demonstrate to councillors on the Planning Committee that villagers are just as determined to prevent the project going ahead as the applicant is to push it through.

The application has also been allocated a new reference number - . **20/02446/F**. This means that all objections quoting the previous reference number will be ignored. Most of these objections remain relevant. One example is access to the site via completely unsuitable roads. This situation has deteriorated during the interim period, with the road edges having eroded further and the verges becoming even more overgrown. However, in order to be taken into account objections must be re-submitted.

There appears to be a delay in loading objections to the website but this cannot account for the current lack of responses. There were well over 100 objections to the previous application. This time to date there are only 24.

The Parish Council has obtained an extension to the deadline for submissions to **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> November**. Villagers are urged to make their feelings known to the planning authorities.
